

Key Agreement

Article XXIV, Sections 1-3 of the Demosthenian Constitution read:

Section 1, Members may obtain a key to the hall provided they have attended nine meetings as a member, have filled out a key agreement and filed it with the Chief Justice, and have paid their key deposit to the Treasurer.

Section 2, Departing members who return their working key to the society will be refunded the full amount of their key deposit. Keys must be returned promptly upon departure from the Society. The Treasurer shall refund the key deposit, provided sufficient notice has been given.

Section 3, Departing members who do not return their key or who hand down a key to a current member upon graduation forfeits their key deposit. Departing members who do not return keys may also be subject to the Student Judiciary for disposition at the discretion of the Chief Justice. Members handing down keys shall be responsible for cutting off at least one node of said key so as to destroy them, to be verified by either the Chief Justice or Hall Administrator.
